Farley-Berens and Andy McCandless, sprang into action. They made meals, cleaned her home and paid a bill or two all in an effort to "lighten the load." Out of these efforts, and the realization that practical resources for single parents with cancer were non-existent, Singleton Moms was born.

Their programs include Singleton Pockets which allocates a small stipend per month towards a household bill. Singleton Kitchen, in partnership with Dream Dinners, provides wellbalanced, pre-prepared family meals. Bare Necessities allows families to stock up on the most needed household items and the Care Team Cleans comes in once a month for a thorough cleaning of the home.

They also surprised us with gifts for Ava on her birthday and Christmas. It's a nice touch." shared Kara, a recipient of Singleton Moms' services.

"Being a single parent myself, I could only imagine the overwhelming news if something happened in my own family.
